Yet, despite this progress, the country still faces crop losses worth nearly ₹2 lakh crores annually due to pests and diseases—while our pesticide usage remains among the lowest globally, at just 400 grams per hectare compared to the global average of 8,000 grams. This clearly reflects the efficiency, precision, and responsibility with which Indian farmers operate.

Through continued focus on innovation, stewardship, and integrated pest management, we can significantly reduce crop losses, enhance farmer incomes, and accelerate India's journey toward a \$1 trillion agricultural economy. Our collective efforts are not only about advancing productivity but also about realizing the national vision of an Atmanirbhar and Viksit Bharat—a self-reliant and globally competitive India where agriculture stands as the cornerstone of sustainable growth".

Our focus remains on educating farmers on responsible usage and supporting them in safeguarding their crops sustainably".
